## Making a bequest to Inala?

A bequest is an exceptional gift and truly, deeply valued. Making provision for a gift is a very personal decision and can take many different forms. You may wish to give:

- a fixed amount of funds
- a percentage or the residue of your estate
- an asset (such as shares, a piece of jewellery or art)
- a life insurance or superannuation policy
- a donation in your lifetime; or
- another gift of your choice.

Inala will accept your gift responsibly and ensure that it directly benefits the individuals we support.

## How do I make a bequest to Inala?

You may also consider using the following clause in your Will, however we recommend seeking advice from your Solicitor to ensure the wording of your bequest is appropriate for the gift you wish to make, and to ensure your wishes are carried out.

"I give and bequeath to Inala (specify gift) for Inala's general purposes and I declare that the receipt of the company secretary or other authorised officer of Inala will be sufficient discharge to my Trustee(s) for my bequest."


## Notifying Inala of your intent to leave a bequest

Notifying us of your intention to leave a bequest to Inala means that we are able to:

- accept your gift with respect to your wishes
- thank you and remember you for your enduring support
- welcome you to the Inala community (optional)
- keep you up to date with the latest progress and news at Inala (optional).

If you prefer to remain anonymous we will respect your wishes. We understand that family and loved ones come first, and that they should be included in your discussions about your Will.

We appreciate that personal circumstances may change and that you may amend your bequest at any time.

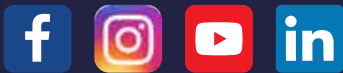
